L The Benefit: The employee, their spouse/partner and dependents are eligible to apply for tuition-free acceptance to undergraduate programs of any participating members of the Council of Independent Colleges. While there is no cap on the number of CIC participants an institution can accept on an annual basis, they are required to accept at least 3 to participate in the tuition exchange program.

L To apply: Simply visit the CIC site to complete the application for the appropriate academic year. Applications should be submitted via the CIC site as early as possible for the following academic year – for example: apply fall 2022 for the AY2023-24. The application can be found at <u>https://my.cic.edu/TEP-Home/Students</u>. An application must be submitted each year for renewal of the benefit. Once the information is submitted into the CIC system, the CIC liaison for UNE will go in and confirm eligibility for the benefit.

L Benefit for dependents: Dependents may participate in undergraduate programs only and can receive free tuition for up to 8 semesters. Some host institutions may permit students to enroll in study abroad programs. The program provides for international exchanges when the exporting and host institutions allow it.

L Benefit for Employee, Spouse or Partner: Same as the benefits outlined for the dependents. In addition some host institutions may permit students to enroll in part-time and graduate programs.
